Leisa & Phil Hanson have a son Adam Born 14-10-95.

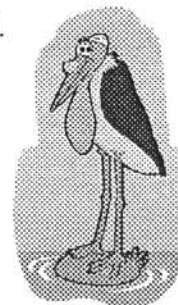
Kimberley has 2 brothers and Jarrah has a brother and sister.

Judy (poo) & Peter Griffin have a daughter, Megann Louise born 1-6-1996. Megann would not have been a SURPRISE 8 years age!

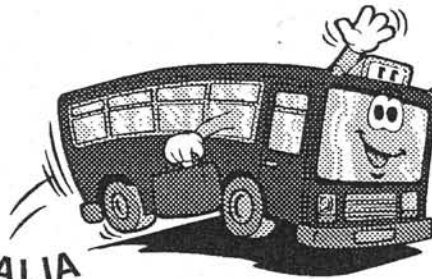
Julie & Geoff Purtill have a daughter Nicky born in early November 1995

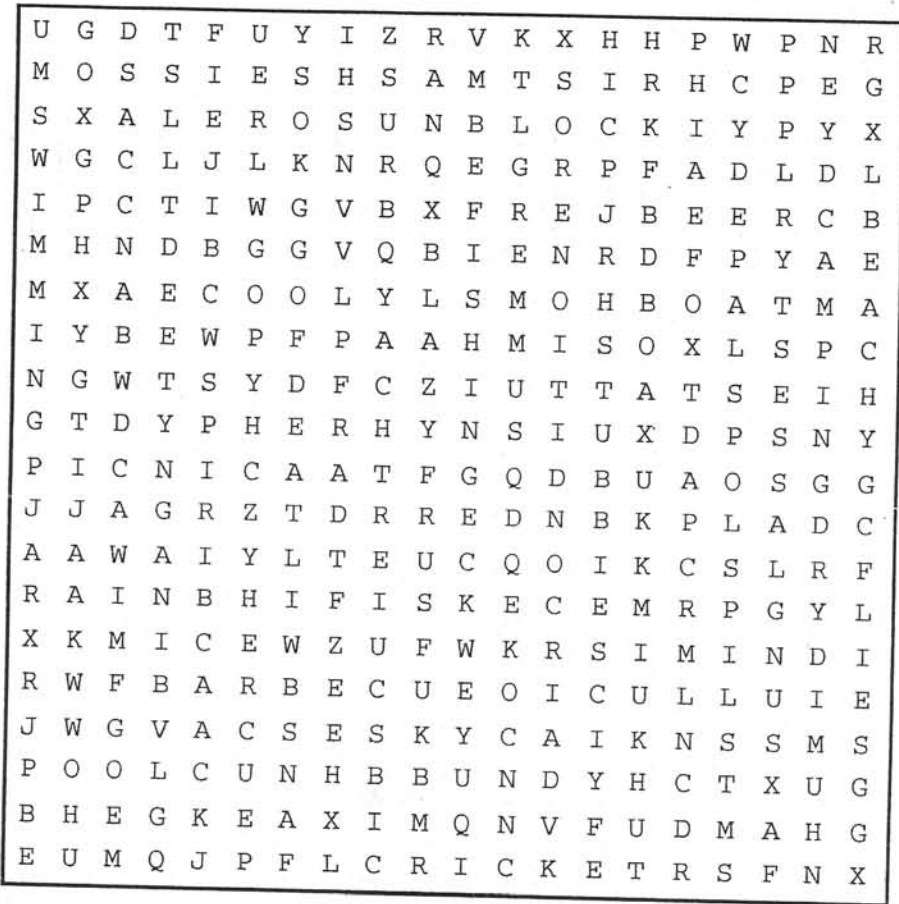
