

### REPORT FROM THE COMMITTEE

After the last ALDECC annual general meeting 2001, the committee was giving consideration to changing the Constitution with the view of having an elected Vice President, who would become President and electing an Assistant Secretary/Treasurer, who would become the Secretary/Treasurer. The reason behind this was to encourage more members to nominate for the committee with the knowledge that they would have support and back up in these roles.

After much debate the committee felt that changing the constitution would not necessarily achieve the desired objective and it would not warrant the cost involved for this change. The committee believes that most members think the role of President or Secretary/Treasurer is too involved or time consuming and therefore people tend to avoid electing for either of these positions.

The committee felt that it would be much better to look at the role of Secretary/Treasurer to see if there was anything that could be shared around to other committee members to lighten the load of this position. One of the best ways to assist the Secretary/Treasurer is to have the newsletter done by 2 other members of the committee in consultation with the Secretary/Treasurer and President. This would give other members jobs to do and help lighten the load. The newsletter is not mentioned in the constitution so has just evolved as a job for the Secretary/Treasurer. It was also agreed that the outgoing Secretary/Treasurer should be there to assist the incoming person during the transition. The Presidents job is not hard.

Having said all of this, the committee feel that if we asked for nominations for the committee earlier in the weekend and not just at the general meeting, we may have a more favorable response. This is your club, your reunion and all members want to enjoy it as much as possible. We need to have new blood regularly on the committee so that we ensure that everyone from the different ear's of the industry are represented and have the opportunity to have input in ALDECC as an organization and the reunion or any other activities that may become possible in the future.

The committee has also decided to have nomination forms with information like who people worked for and when so everyone at the AGM has a better idea of who has been nominated and who they are.
