

It takes less than a minute to work this out as you read.


This isn't one of those waste of time things, it's fun!

The following letter was sent to Barb back in April. For those of you who don't know Alan , he was a courier with Camping Tours of Australia or Centralian as most people would know it as, at the same time as Garry Mathewson. Alan is a past member of ALDECC.

Dear Friend.

We are writing to you as a friend, either one we see regularly, irregularly or someone on our Christmas card list. A strange letter we admit but one that we hope will produce a positive outcome.

Due to an unfortunate accident Alan is a quadriplegic and has been since May 2<sup>nd</sup> 1992. The shinning light for us is an organization called the Spinal Cord Society. It is a non profit research group run by a paraplegic with one goal and that is to find a cure for paralysis caused by spinal cord injury. The SCS has been in research since 1978 and is a leading group striving for a cure.

The research has reached a stage where trials with autologus stem cell production using human cells is about to take place at Peter McCullum Institute, Melbourne. Autologus stem cell production does not use embryos. The stem cells are obtained from a patient's own brain t - cells. SCS moved past embryonic stem cell development several years ago. This is a major step forward and is terrific to see that SCS Australia has come on board with the American research. We now raise funds that go to America as well as funds to support the two Australian Fellowships largely funded by the Traralgon Lions club as well as International Lions.

Alan has been confined to a wheelchair for 10 years this May. To acknowledge this, but in no way to celebrate it, we would like to make a significant contribution to SCS to help fund a cure that will get Alan out of his chair. We are therefore asking the people we know to help us achieve this by also donating something to SCS Australia during May.

This is an honest and open request, however, we do not wish to embarrass anyone who does not wish to contribute. To respect your right to make your own decision to contribute or not and if you are willing to support us, the amount is also a private matter. Therefore if you are willing and able to contribute something to our May fundraiser please send a cheque to SCS Australia directly on our behalf. More than \$2 is tax deductible

We live for the day that Alan will be able to get out of bed, toilet, shower, dress himself and do so in privacy. It is the little things that one takes for granted that he craves and one day we believe he will have thanks to the research being conducted by SCS.
